Yard Debris Pick-Up Program

This yard debris pick-up service is for an amenity provided by the association for Mountain Park homeowners. The association's landscape crew picks up yard debris that is left at curb side every Monday. There is no additional fee for the service. Please follow these guidelines:

- Please use paper leaf bags or heavy duty garbage for grass and leaves. Bags must not exceed 25 lbs.
- Stumps and branches must be under 4 inches in diameter to be picked up.
- Please put branches and twigs in bundles and tie tightly with strong twine. Branches not to exceed 8 feet long. Free twine is available at the clubhouse.
- Only yard debris is accepted—no garbage, please.
- Put debris curb side the night before pickup or before 6:30 am the day of pickup.
